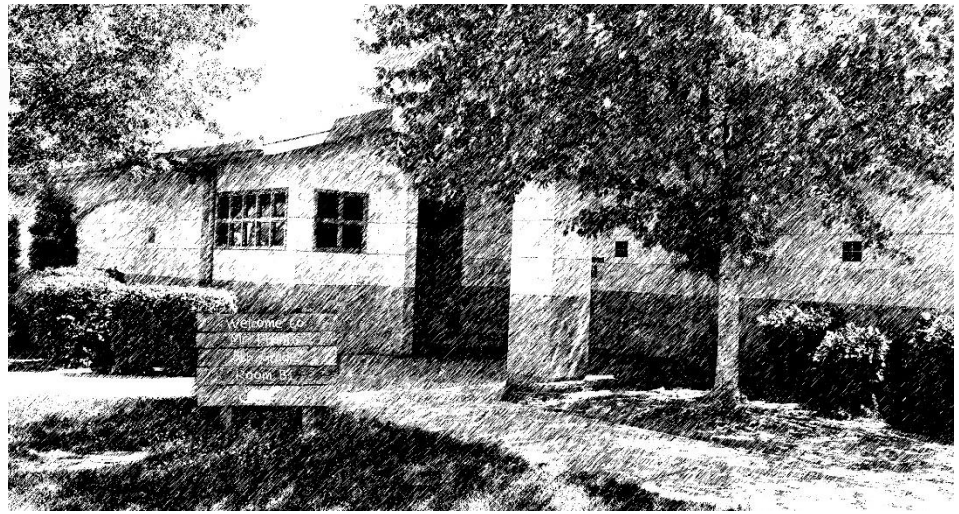

May your journeys be filled with many, many more happy moments.

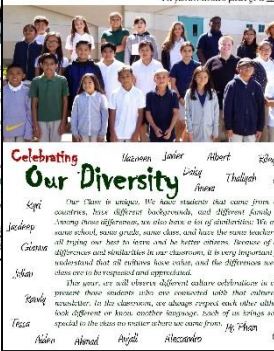

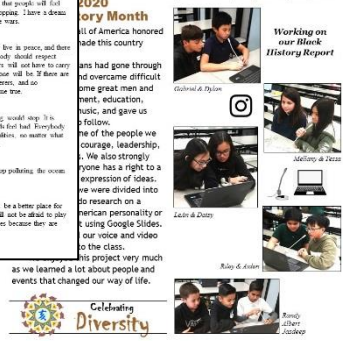

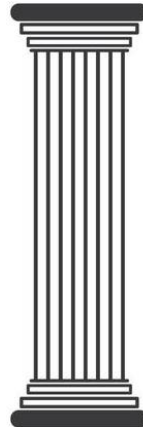

What are Students thinking?

Do you think you're in school too long? Do you watch TV about three hours each day? And if some money suddenly appeared in your life, would you just as soon spend it then save it?

Yes, yes and yes – at least according to a new survey of 1,500 students. The survey, **"The Mood of American Youth,"** was compiled by the National Association of School Principals. It concentrates on school, but also takes a look at a wide range of subjects. Here are some of the highlights.

School. More than 70 percent* of the students said they enjoy most about school is their friends. Other things they say they enjoy are sports (31/2%), learning (17.1), social activities (16), teachers (15.1) and classes (10.2).

Teachers. Nearly one third of the students say the ability to explain things clearly is one of the most important qualities of a good teacher. Other qualities mentioned are concern and kindness (18.2) and good attitude and friendliness (15.7).

Hobbies. The hobby enjoyed by most of the students (64.9%) is sports and fitness. Other favorite hobbies are reading (49.10), music (43.8), cooking (39.9), collecting things (39.8), art (32.9), computers (27.3) and dancing (23.4).

After graduation. More than half plan to go on to college. About 36 % will get full time jobs, 14.8% will go to junior college and 14.8% will attend vocational or training school. Marriage was marked by 13.3%, while 11.1% planned to join the military.

Careers. Computer-related careers are indisputably the most highly desired occupations especially with the growth of internet usage – 16.7% want to break into that field. The business world appeals to 7.3%, while 6.6% hope to become doctors. Teaching (5.6), law (4.5), engineering (4.2), accounting (3.8) and professional sports (3.8) also have their fans.

World problems. For 37%, the threat of nuclear disaster was the world's No. 1 problem, with threats like North Korea, Iran, Russia, and Syria. Threat of World War III concerns 21.3%, poverty 15.1%. Overpopulation (10.5) and environmental problems (6.5), the No.1 and No.2 concerns 10 years ago, dropped to fourth and fifth place this year.

Life goal. To the question, "What is the one thing that you want out of life?" 27.6% mentioned career success. Happiness in general comes in second with 25.7%, followed by marriage and family (20.8), general success (9.8), financial success (7) and a long, enjoyable life (4.2).

** Some sets of percentages will exceed 100 percent since students were allowed on certain questions to make more than one choice. Where the total of the percentages is below 100, not all responses are listed.*

- A MEAN** teacher produces students who are respectful, responsible, and successful.

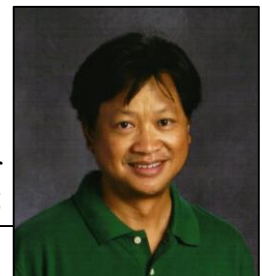

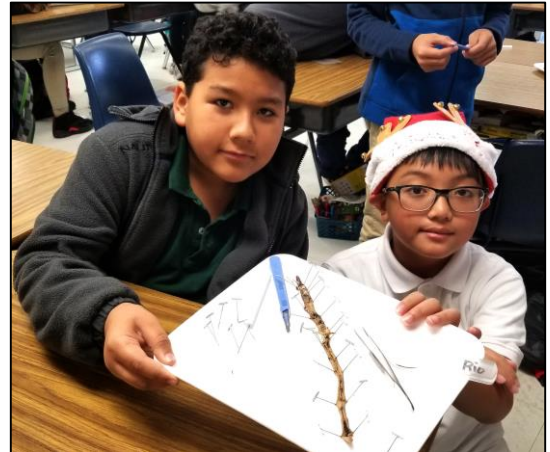
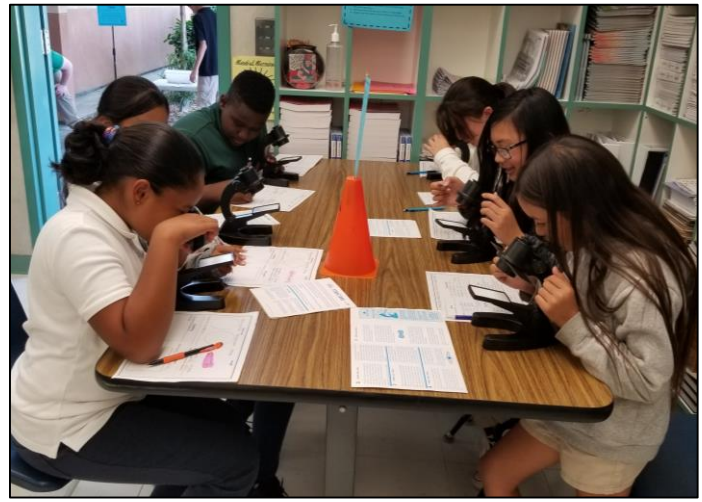
Learning Activities

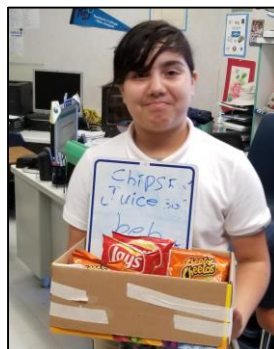
Our class enjoyed doing presentations throughout the year. The purpose was to build speaking and listening skills. They were also lots of fun!!!





Flea Market Fridays

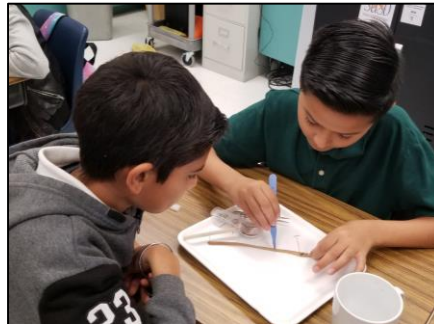
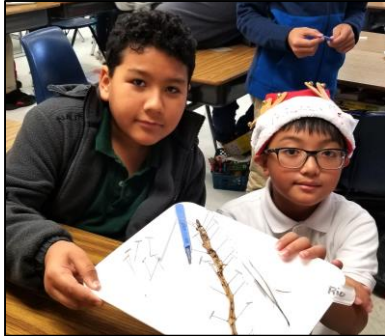

Worm Anatomy Study

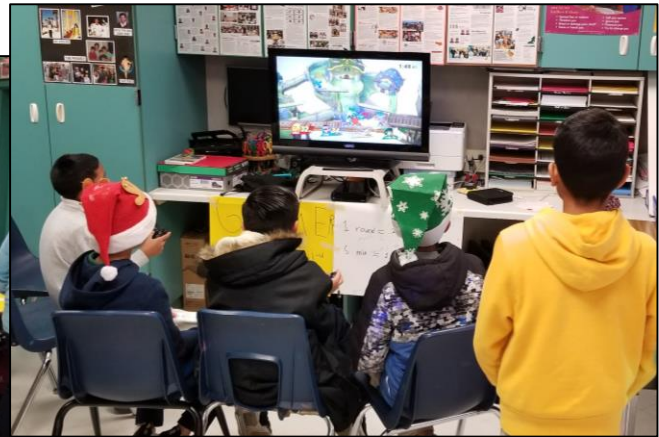
As a part of our Ecology Unit which includes studying producers, consumers, and decomposers, we studied the worm habitat and why worms are so important to the soil's nutrients and aeration which are beneficial to plants. We also found out why do earthworms like dirt and how their anatomy works to filter the food in the soil. We constructed a paper model of the worm and learned about the functions of 14 different worm parts. Finally, we dissected real worms and connected what we've learned to actual worm anatomy. 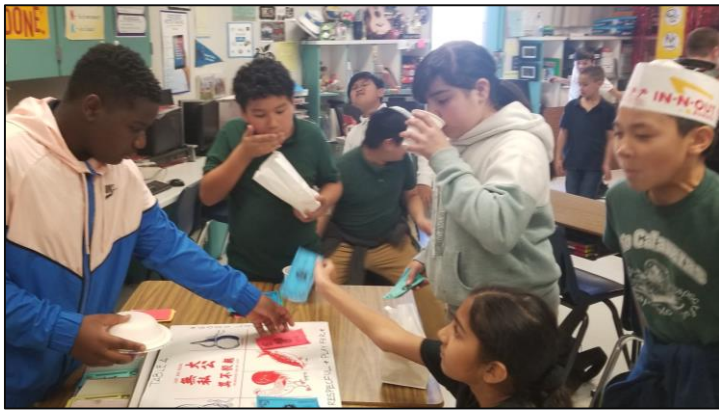




Class Carnival

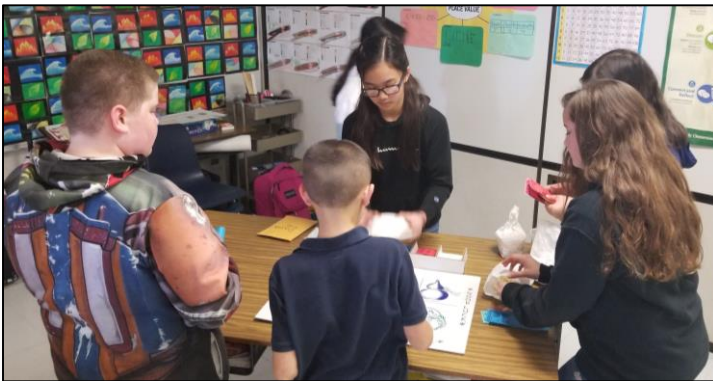

Lunar New Year Celebration

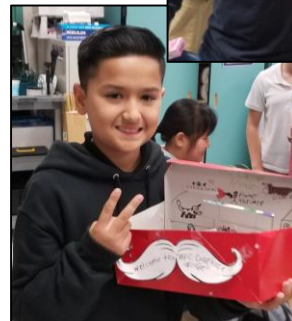

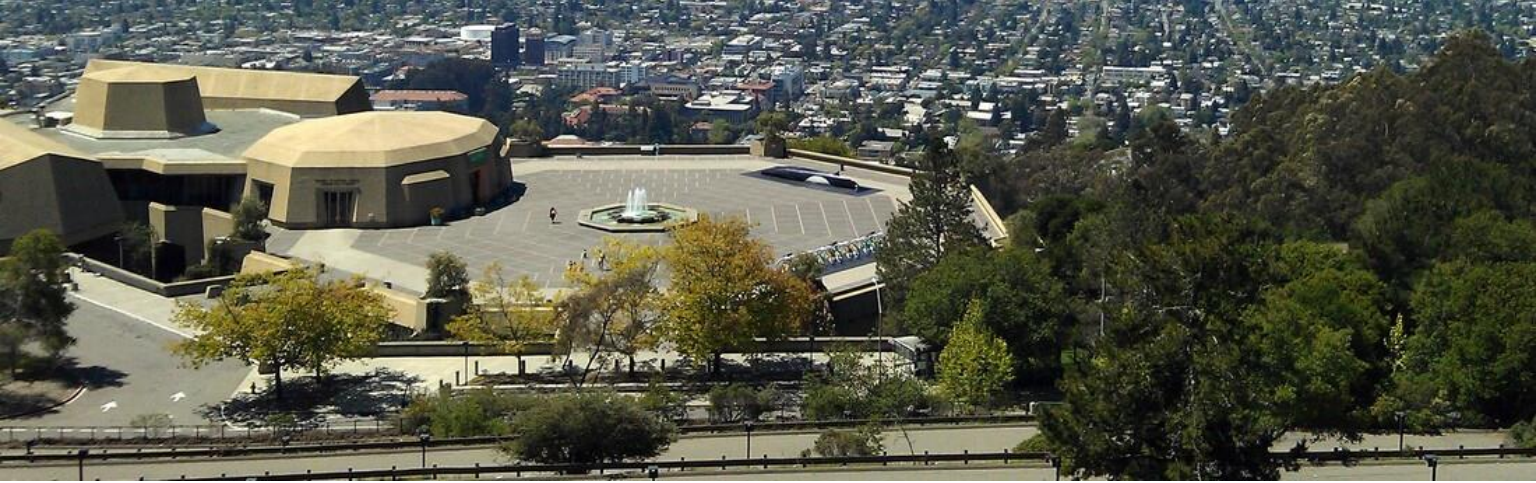




Valentine Celebration

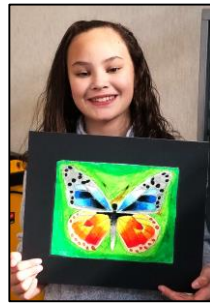
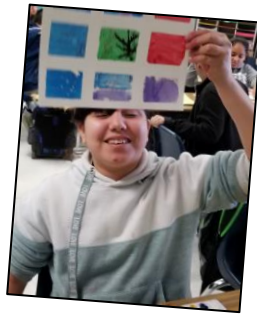
For us in Mr. Pham's 5th grade class this year, art time is fun time!

- Finally, we try our hands at photography using digital cameras and computer programs.

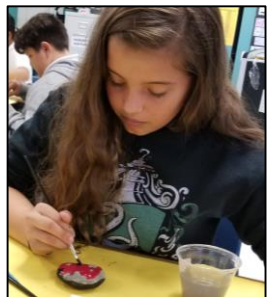

Improve your swimming – Finally learn that backstroke or float on water. This can be helpful in the future.

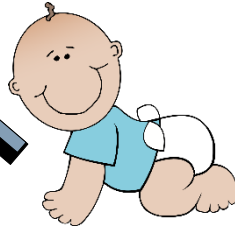
